## HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

- Make sure to print this guide with paper scaling set to "100\%". Please use ruler to vertify the scale by measuring above boxed area.
- Measure your finger at the lime of the day when it will be at its largest - This is usually at the end of the day.
- Avoid measuring your fingers when they are cold or damp, as they will be at their smallest.
- Bands or rings over 5 mm in widh may fit your finger more tightly than narrow rings of the same size.


## USING THIS GUIDE WITH RING CIRCLES

1. Choose one of the rings that fits well on her ring finger.
2. Lay her ring over a circle that is closest to the size of her ring.
3. Find the circle that fills the entire inner-circle of her ring. For accuracy, no part of the circle should be visible outside the ring when viewed from above.
4. If the size of the ring seems to fall between two sizes, order the larger ring size.
